TECHNICAL GUIDE NOTICE ND-124

This notice transmits revisions to the Field Office Technical Guide (FOTG) as follows:

Section IV

- A new conservation practice standard, Agricultural Secondary Containment Facility (710) (Interim) has been added to the Conservation Practices Folder. Please note, the Specification, Operation and Maintenance Plan, and Statement of Work are being developed and will be posted as soon as they are completed. This standard will be used in conjunction with the Environmental Quality Incentive Program Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure pilot initiative to help farmers comply with EPA regulations.
- The Conservation Practice Specification for Fence (382) has been revised as follows:
 - Smooth Wire has been added to the General Purpose Fence, Materials section.
 - Wildlife Friendly Fence specifications have been revised.
 - Livestock Windbreak Fence specifications have been added for Portable Fabricated Windbreaks and Permanent Fabricated Windbreaks.
 - ND Conservation Job Sheet 25 for Portable Windbreak Fence, and ND Conservation Job Sheet 26 and Job Sheet 27 for Permanent Fabricated Windbreak Fence have been added to Planning Requirements – Item C.
- North Dakota Conservation Job Sheets 25 – Portable Fabricated Windbreak, 26 – Solid Fabricated Windbreak Straight Line for Feedlot Use, and 27 – Porous Fabricated Windbreak Straight Line for Feedlot Use have been added to Section IV – Conservation Practices – Fence (382).
