## TECHNICAL GUIDE NOTICE ND-6

This notice transmits field office specific information on Wellhead Protection (WHP) Program areas for Section 1, Reference List.

At the present time, nearly 300 North Dakota communities rely on groundwater as their sole source of drinking water.

The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDH) has developed and is implementing a proactive groundwater protection program called WHP. The Federal Safe Drinking Water Act Amendments of 1986 created WHP and delegated authority to implement the program at the State level. Groundwater protection is accomplished at the local level through the voluntary actions of the individual public water supplier throughout the State.

Field offices listed on this notice will be provided a hard copy of the WHP material for their use. As you work with producers in the WHP areas, consider the WHP Program as another resource issue we should address. Should you require the specific information referenced in the appendices, please contact NDDH, WHP Program, Division of Water Quality.
