TECHNICAL GUIDE NOTICE ND-70

This notice announces that links to Conservation Systems (CSs) and Conservation System Guides (CSGs) for each North Dakota county are now posted in the electronic Field Office Technical Guide. The CS and CSG links are located in Section III - Conservation Systems - Conservation System Guides subfolder.

Since September 2004, many new CSs and CSGs have been added for non-irrigated cropland, hayland, tame pasture, range, and wildlife land. The new CSs and CSGs provide many more scenarios for planners to more accurately report “before” conditions (CSGs) and “after” conditions resulting from practice combinations actually applied (CSs).

The following contents have been removed from the Field Office Technical Guide - Section III- Guidance Documents –

- Cropland Management Systems/Effects
- Hayland Management Systems/Effects
- Headquarters Management Systems/Effects
- Pasture Management Systems/Effects

This Notice also announces a revision of the map, “Common Resource Areas (CRA) in North Dakota” located in Section I - Maps subfolder. The revised map shows the correct locations of Common Resource Areas 53B.1 and 53B.2, which were reversed on the old map.
