## Diseases of Trees in the Great Plains

"Diseases of Trees in the Great Plains," GTR RM-129, is enclosed to provide a tree disease reference for your use. The handbook includes most diseases of trees in the Great Plains and describes them as they occur in this area.

This handbook will assist in diagnosing tree diseases and recommending control measures. However, it does not replace the need to seek assistance from cooperating agencies. You should continue to request assistance from the Cooperative Extension Service (CES) in your area. The CES is your link to the University and District Foresters when their assistance is needed on complex tree situations. Assistance is also available from the SCS Forester in the State Office.

The handbook is the result of cooperative efforts by several forestry-related agencies. The Forestry Committee of the Great Plains Agricultural Council recognized the need for the handbook, promoted and directed its development and pursued funding. Printing and funding were provided by the Rocky Mountain Forest and Range Experiment Station of the USDA Forest Service.
