#### Develop additional water source(s) to improve livestock distribution

Payment = \$1.00 for all acres inside management units where additional water sources are developed. This payment will be initiated the year additional water sources are developed and applied.

The water source should be strategically placed so that utilization of vegetation within the pasture becomes more uniform, or that under-utilized areas are grazed and over-utilized areas receive less grazing pressure.

**Documentation Required:** Use the following table for documentation and attach a plan map showing the location of the newly developed water sources. An example is provided to assist you.

**Operation:** Develop new water source in and underserved or otherwise strategic location. Water developments should ensure 3 days of storage for the number and kind of animals using a grazing unit.

**Maintenance:** Routine maintenance is required to ensure the water development is operational during livestock occupation periods.

**Documentation:** Receipts of well drilling and/or pipeline installation, water tank purchase, dam or pond development, or spring and signed certification the practice has been applied. Newly developed water sources should also be identified on the plan map.
