**Manage grazing lands to improve livestock distribution by developing and maintaining one additional water source**

Payment = \$ \_\_\_\_\_ / Acre / Year for each acre in management units where an additional water source is developed. This payment will be initiated the year additional water sources are developed and applied.

**Requirements:**

- An additional water source will be strategically placed so that utilization of vegetation within the pasture becomes more uniform.
- Water developments will ensure 3 days of storage for the number and kind of grazing animals.
- At least one additional water source must be developed and existing water sources maintained.

**Maintenance:**

- Routine maintenance is required to ensure the water development is operational during livestock grazing periods.
