Fence Construction Jobsheet

NE-CPA-1

Instructions for use of NE-CPA-1

Front:

1. Complete all appropriate blanks for name, address, and program (EQIP, CRP, WRP, or other).
2. Complete all blocks for field number(s), contract number(s) or agreement number(s), fence planned, and fence installed (rods and/or linear feet).
3. Complete sketch as to location of planned fence and scale.
4. Complete legal description.

Reverse:

1. Utilize the appropriate type of fence to be constructed (standard, suspension, or permanent electric).
2. Check kind of line, corner, gate, brace and horizontal bracing posts.
3. Check post spacing and kind of wire or appendages.
4. The cooperator or technician must certify the installed fence(s) meets specifications by signature and date.
