Instructions for use of NE-CPA-21

The township or multi-township plat map may be used to identify the cooperator's land holdings included in the conservation plan.

This form is available as a spreadsheet or a pdf form.

Pdf document

1. Each box represents 40 acres.
2. Select a box that is within the conservation plan being mapped.
3. Upon selection, the box will turn red, select all boxes that apply to the conservation plan.

Spreadsheet

1. Each box represents 40 acres
2. Select a box that is within the conservation plan being mapped.
3. In the home menu at the top, under the font section, select "fill color"
4. This will change the background color of the selected box, to change the color, select the desired color from the drop down box beside the "fill color" icon.
5. Repeat for all boxes within the conservation plan. Multiple boxes can be selected at the same time by selecting one box, and dragging the mouse to include all of the desired boxes.
6. The spreadsheet also has a single township spread sheet. It can be filled the same way, noting that each box represents only 10 acres.
