Nutrient & Irrigation Management Record Keeping Job Sheet

NE-CPA-78

Instructions for use of NE-CPA-78

1. The Nutrient & Irrigation Management Record Keeping Job Sheet (NE-CPA-78) can be provided to clients for reporting Nutrient Management (590 Standard) and Irrigation Management Certification (449 Standard). This form allows for multiple field use. It can be used as an alternative to the Nutrient Budget (NE-CPA-38) and Irrigation Job Sheets (NE-ENG-79A and NE-ENG-80). It is designed to streamline reporting requirements.
2. Complete all appropriate blanks for names, county, NRD and State.
3. Complete the entire table as applicable to the operation.
4. Group fields with similar crop rotation, yields, irrigation management, nutrient application, and field operations.
5. Attach copies of field maps.
6. Attach most recent Soil Test Reports.
7. Attach most recent and applicable Irrigation Water Nitrate Analysis Reports.
8. Attach most recent and applicable Manure Analysis Reports.
