This is an optional form that has been developed for tracking an individuals training, certification, ratings, levels, and dates completed, this new NE-CPA-93 was formerly Exhibit F, "Individual Certification/Rating/Levels".

The Reviewer should complete the Employees Present Level of Understanding on a Scale of 1 to 5:

1. Awareness
2. Understand
3. Perform with Supervision
4. Apply Independently
5. Proficient and Can Train Others

The Planned Level is the level that the employee should reach for their grade and series.
