Instructions for use of NE-ENG-77

All wells that are plugged must be reported to the Nebraska Department of Natural Resources (DNR). Wells will be plugged in accordance with Title 178, Chapter 12, Section 012 of the Department of Health. Parts of Section 012 are included on this form.

State law requires that a copy of the completed DNR form DECO, "Notice of Water Well Decommissioning" be sent to the DNR within 60 days of decommissioning of the water well. A copy of this completed form will be attached to the NE-ENG-77 when it is returned to the NRCS.
