Comments on Classification of Conservation Practices for Cultural Resources Review for

### **ROOF RUNOFF STRUCTURE**

The application of conservation activity, roof runoff structure, must be reviewed (+) for potential effects on cultural resources. Planners should review related ground disturbance that could occur with installation of underground outlets or structures needed to collect and store water from roofs. In addition, be aware the addition of a roof runoff structure to a historic building or structure could be an adverse effect to the property. Typically, field office employees identifying cultural resource indicators will not have the expertise to determine if a structure or building is potentially significant, and it is required that all roof runoff structures being applied to buildings or structures fifty years or older be submitted to the Nebraska State Cultural Resources Specialist for review.
