SUBJECT: ECS – AGRONOMY TECHNICAL NOTE NO. NE-110

Purpose. To transmit the revised Nebraska Agronomy Technical Note No. 110 Agronomy Technical Note is on Pest Management in Conservation Planning Process and is intended to provide guidance to conservation planners working with landusers who are implementing Integrated Pest Management (IPM).

This information is provided in order to help planners develop a conservation plan for IPM using WIN-PST and apply the IPM (Code 595) Standard. In addition, a brief overview of WIN-PST and example is provided for guidance.

Through risk analysis, if a pesticide related water quality concern is identified, the 595 standard requires a specific level of mitigation based on WIN-PST (or Weedsoft) results. Mitigation requirements can be met with IPM techniques and/or conservation practices. The two tables (found within this agronomy technical note) provide IPM techniques and conservation practices with their corresponding mitigation values:

- Table 1 - IPM Techniques for Reducing Pesticide Environmental Risk and
- Table II – Conservation Practices for Reducing Pesticide Environment Risk.
