SUBJECT: ECS – AGRONOMY TECHNICAL NOTE NO. NE-111

Purpose. To transmit Nebraska Agronomy Technical Note No. 111 on Controlling Ephemeral Gully Erosion on Highly Erodible Land. The purpose of the Technical Note is to provide guidance to conservation planners to determine when and where ephemeral gully erosion control measures are needed and how to plan, document and implement the appropriate erosion control practices.
