§NE512.21 Evaluation procedures.

(a)(5) Most materials delivered to a site to be incorporated into a conservation practice are manufactured or fabricated under controlled conditions. The manufacturer normally stamps either the product or container with the list of ASTM, production standards, and/or federal specifications the material meets. The jobsite examination and/or testing of materials shall be documented on the job sheet, NE-ENG-49(49a), or field diary. The name of the manufacturer and a statement that the product is labeled or tagged properly and a record of the pertinent data on the tag usually is all that is necessary to document the field evaluation of the delivered material quality. This does not eliminate the requirement for submitting design mix, where required by specification, for concrete or materials delivered under a contracted works where a material certification has not been waived.
