

**NRCS STATE LEVEL AGREEMENTS FOR CULTURAL RESOURCES
COMPLIANCE**

NRCS-Nebraska has entered into state level agreements with the Nebraska Historic Preservation Office and four tribal governments in order to streamline compliance with Section 106 of the NHPA. These documents also formalize the cultural resources procedures on a statewide level between each of these entities and define the expectations for NRCS to notify and consult the other parties during the cultural resources review process.
