Windbreak Renovation

“Windbreak Renovation,” was developed by authors from NRCS-North Dakota, Nebraska Forest Service, University of Nebraska, and Utah State University. Nine renovation techniques are presented, along with a field windbreak key to sort out which renovation technique(s) to use. Nebraska conservationists should find this reference useful when planning a windbreak renovation. This note should be used in conjunction with Nebraska NRCS Windbreak Renovation Standard 650 and Design Procedures 650DP, while keeping in mind that the standard and design procedures prevail in cases of information conflicts. Assistance in planning windbreak renovations can be provided by NFS district foresters or conservation field foresters.
