SUBJECT: ECS – RANGE AND PASTURE TECHNICAL NOTE

Purpose. To issue Technical Note 15 and 16

Effective Date. Effective when received

Explanation. This Range and Pasture Technical Note is for Technical Note 15 on Procedures for Conducting Grazing Land Inventory and Assessment. The following Technical Note outlines a process for completing a grazing land (rangeland, pastureland, annual forages, hayland, and/or crop aftermath) inventory of a grazing management unit or ranch. This process should be completed on site with the manager in order to get a complete understanding of the operation.

Technical Note 16 provides the Minimum Standards for NE NRCS Photo-Point Monitoring. A photographic record is a qualitative method for documenting short-term and long-term effects of prescribed grazing plans. Permanent photographs of a landscape are useful for visually documenting vegetation changes.

Filing Instructions. File the Range and Pasture Technical Note 15 and 16 in your Nebraska Range and Pasture Handbook. Also update the Technical Note Index in your Nebraska Range and Pasture Handbook.
