Explanation. The Targeted Grazing technical note gives guidance to conservation planners and landowners; on how to plan, prepare and schedule grazing as a treatment for invasive plant management. This information includes guidance in establishing effective stock densities, plant preferences by livestock species, and suggested number of treatment cycles.

The Salt Cedar technical note provides information about the characteristics of salt cedar as an invasive woody plant species with guidance on control and management.
