Explanation. Range and Pasture Technical Note 24 – Fire Effects on selected shrubs, forbs, and grasses – Prescribed fire can be used as a vegetation management tool in a variety of landscapes to achieve a wide range of conservation goals.

Range and Pasture Technical Note 24 is intended to provide guidance to Field Office employees on the effects of Prescribed Fire on a variety of shrubs, forbs, and grasses. This note should be used to determine the effectiveness of prescribed fire as a management tool in specific situations and the potential damage to non-target species as well as the effectiveness on the species to be controlled.
