NE-380DP – Windbreak/Shelterbelt Establishment Design Procedures

- Page 1, Part I/A/c – “An EXCEPTION exists for livestock windbreaks on sandy soils in Vegetative Zones I and II”.
- Page 4, Part II/A/i/3) – “The following is the EXCEPTION to the generally applied guidance regarding windbreak plantings”.

**Jobsheets, Engineering Drawings and Construction Specs** – not technically included in the Tech Guide, but reflects changes in section IV.

- The name of Job Sheet NE-CPA-15, Tree and Shrub Planting Plan, has been changed to Tree and Shrub Planting Job Sheet. The format has been revised to include the new programs under the FY14 Farm Bill, revised map requirements, and a Required Check-off Signatures block.
- The NE CPA-666 Job Sheet for Forest Stand Improvement has been revised to include a Required Check-off Signatures block.
