

TYPICAL PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED ON FORESTLAND

Soil Related Problems

- Erosion

Water Related Problems

- Adversely changed surface water flow
- Restricted capacity of ponds and conveyance systems
- Sediment and suspended solids contamination of surface water
- Inadequate water for fire suppression purposes
- Nutrient contamination of surface water

Air Related Problems

- Generally not applicable in New Hampshire

Plant Related Problems

- Poorly suited to site conditions
- Poorly suited to meeting land users objectives
- Lack desired quality and quantity
- Poor health and vigor
- Potential destruction of natural plant communities that include rare or endangered species

Animal Related Problems

- Inadequate food and cover
- Reduced or damaged habitat
