

TYPICAL PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED ON MINED LAND

Soil Related Problems

- Sheet and rill erosion
- Ephemeral gully erosion
- Classic gully erosion
- Poor soil tilth
- Sediment deposits that cause unsafe conditions or property damage on roads and other locations

Water Related Problems

- Restricted capacity of ponds, lakes, streams, and water conveyances
- Sediment and suspended solids contamination of surface water

Air Related Problems

- Particulates that cause health, safety and property damage

Plant Related Problems

- Plants are not well suited to the site
- Plants do not provide the desired quantity of cover
- Plants lack adequate health and vigor

Animal Related Problems

- Inadequate food and cover to meet the requirements of the species of concern
