DESIGN

Deliverables:

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices
 - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
 - b. List all required and/or facilitating practices
 - c. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
 - i. Crops to be grown
 - ii. Sequence of crops and length of crop rotation
 - iii. Soil quality considerations
 - iv. Wildlife considerations
2. Operation and maintenance plan
3. Certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and comply with applicable laws and regulations
4. Design modifications during application as required

INSTALLATION

Deliverables

1. Pre-application conference with client
2. Application guidance as needed
3. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer
4. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during application
5. Certification that the application process and materials meets design and permit requirements

 - b. Crops actually planted
 - c. Soil Conditioning Index calculations
2. Certification that the application meets NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits
3. Progress reporting
