This work in 3 volumes provides background on philosophy, processes, plant materials selection, site preparation and seed and seeding equipment for revegetating disturbed rangelands and emphasizes use of native species. The 29 chapters include guidelines for planning, conducting and managing a rangeland seeding project. It also contains a compilation of rangeland revegetation research conducted over the last several decades to aid practitioners in reestablishing healthy communities and curbing the spread of invasive species.
