CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATION

500 - OBSTRUCTION REMOVAL

1. SCOPE

The work shall consist of the removal and disposal of marked structures, fences, woody vegetation, rock and other debris as shown on the drawings or as located in the field.

2. MARKING

The limits of the areas from which obstructions must be removed will be marked by means of stakes, flags or other suitable methods as shown on the drawings or as specified in Section 6. Structures requiring obstruction removal outside the limits of the area for obstruction removal will be marked by means of flags, painted marks or other suitable means as described in Section 6. Structures to be preserved in place will be designated by special markings.

3. REMOVAL

Items such as boulders, large rocks, old concrete, woody vegetation and other debris such as scrap metal, fence wire, or other items as identified in Section 6 that are considered obstructions shall be removed from within the limits of the proposed site area.

4. SALVAGE AND DISPOSAL OF REFUSE MATERIALS

When specified for re-use, boulders, large rocks, and old concrete which are durable will be salvaged and stockpiled for later use in the site foundation subgrade or as specified in Section 6. Boulders, large rocks and old concrete will be considered refuse material for disposal, if not specified for re-use.

Refuse material resulting from obstruction removal shall be removed from the project site and be disposed of at a legal disposal site, unless otherwise shown on the drawings or as specified in Section 6.

5. MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Payment for Obstruction Removal will be made at the contract lump sum price. Such payment will constitute full compensation for all labor, materials, equipment, tools, and other appurtenances necessary and incidental to the completion of the work.

Compensation for any item of work described in the contract but not listed in the bid schedule will be included in the payment for the item of work to which it is made subsidiary. Such items and the items to which they are made subsidiary are identified in Section 6.

6. ITEMS OF WORK AND ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:
