The NY's Erosion and Sediment Control statement was added to following ground disturbing practices:

Anaerobic Digester – 366, Fish Raceway or Tank – 398, Irrigation ditch Lining – 428, Irrigation Pipeline – 430, Roof Runoff Structure – 558, Surface drain – 607, Surface Drainage, Main or Lateral – 608, Surface Roughening – 609.

Made the following changes to Roof Runoff Structure – 558;

Removed the Statement "Collection and use for other purposes such as irrigation and animal watering facility"

Altered Paragraph 6 to say "Gravel filled trenches instead of Rock-filled trenches"

Under Additional Criteria to Increase Water Quantity- removed paragraph about "portable water usage"

Under Considerations removed the second paragraph.

Anaerobic Digester – 366 Under Considerations changed hydrologically sensitive areas to Streams and Flood Plains.
