Inspections and maintenance are required to achieve the intended function, benefits, and life of the practice. The landowner/operator is responsible to establish and implement an inspection and maintenance program. Items to inspect and maintain during the 15-year design life of the practice include, but are not limited to, the following:

General Recommendations:

- Provide periodic inspections, especially immediately following storms with a 10-year or greater return frequency to identify repair and maintenance needs.
- Keep roof runoff structures clean and free of obstructions that reduce flow.
- Conduct maintenance and repairs in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations.
- Promptly repair or replace all damaged, inoperable or missing components and safety features to ensure they are functional, structurally sound, and are not a safety hazard. Repair as needed.
- Protect the components from damage by farm equipment and livestock. Promptly repair or replace damaged or inoperable components.
- Remove any trees or branches that deposit debris and reduce the capacity of the system.

Special Considerations:

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Optional items to consider:

- Maintain effective erosion control of the contributing watershed to prevent sedimentation and the resulting loss of capacity.
- Where the roof runoff structure discharges into an underground outlet, follow the Operation and Maintenance Plan for Underground Outlet.
