

STATEMENT OF WORK

These deliverables apply to this individual practice. For other planned practice deliverables refer to those specific Statements of Work.

DESIGN

Deliverables:

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices
 - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
 - b. List of required permits to be obtained by the client
 - c. List all required and/or facilitating practices
 - d. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
 - i. Crop rotation
 - ii. Crop row width
 - iii. Type and width of each piece of field equipment with tire/track spacing
 - iv. Percent of field tracked and layout of tramlines.
 - v. Tire types and air pressures used for each equipment type.
2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to install the practice and obtain necessary permits.
3. Operation and maintenance plan
4. Certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and comply with applicable laws and regulations
5. Design modifications during installation as required

INSTALLATION

Deliverables

1. Pre-installation conference with client.
2. Verification that client has obtained required permits.
3. Layout according to plans and specifications including applicable layout notes.
4. Installation guidance as needed.
5. Installation inspection (according to inspection plan as appropriate).
 - a. Actual layouts and equipment used.
 - b. Inspection records
6. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer.
7. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during installation.
8. Certification that the installation process and materials meets design and permit requirements.

CHECK OUT

Deliverables

1. Records of installation
 - a. Actual equipment used with wheel/track specifications.
 - b. Extent of practice units applied on plan map.
 - c. Actual layout used for tramlines on plan map.
2. Certification that the installation meets NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits
3. Progress reporting
