



Ingress / Egress is through an existing driveway into the headquarters that comes from TWP HWY 120. There will be no borrow areas for any of these projects. Soil will be stripped from the location that the practice will be installed and redistributed within that same area.

The headquarters is approximately 4 acres in size. The property around the headquarters has been crops for many years. At the headquarters there are buildings: barns, grain bins, and a house. The house is older than 50 years. None of the structures at the headquarters will be affected by the construction of the practices. The farm drains into the Scioto River. There is one archeological site within 2KM of the work area. Even though the work area will disturb more than one acre, no known archaeological sites will be disturbed.


