

SHORT TERM STORAGE OF ANIMAL WASTE AND BYPRODUCTS INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF SPECIFICATION 318

1. APPLICABILITY

Temporary, non-structural measures used to store solid or semi-solid, organic agricultural waste or manure (stackable livestock and poultry manure, bedding, litter, spilled feed, or soil mixed with manure) on a short-term basis between collection and utilization.

2. ITEMS TO BE INCLUDED ON DRAWINGS OR SECTION 5 OF THE CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS

a. Planview map

- (1) Location of all stockpile areas
- (2) Dimensions, L and W
- (3) Access road to site
- (4) Location of any sensitives and setbacks

b. Narrative

- (1) Stockpile period
- (2) Minimum or Maximum stacking height and shape
- (3) Type of cover or options
- (4) Installation guidelines for cover, minimum lap, anchor spacing, O&M, etc.
- (5) Minimum buffer and buffer O&M

- (6) Stockpile area O&M
- (7) Lime, seeding, mulch, etc. for disturbed areas beyond stacking area
- (8) Suitability statement of existing site or additional pad and liner requirements
- (9) Erosion and Sedimentation control requirements, if applicable
- (10) Location of utilities and notification requirements
- (11) Fly control requirements, as applicable

c. Details

- (1) Improved pads need details on construction. Type, depth, materials, etc.
- (2) X-section showing cuts and fill, if applicable
- (3) Method of anchoring
- (4) Type for cover material
