Purpose. (1) To provide new data from weather stations on frost, growth, taps and wetlands in PA counties and the surrounding counties. This data comes from the Water and Climate website in Portland, OR. Each district conservationist will receive county data by e-mail from Susan Hoffman.

(2) To ensure individual county information from the National Register of Historic Places is filed correctly.

Background. (1) General Manual 450-GM, Amendment 9, March 2000, discusses items to be filed under Section II of the Field Office Technical Guide (FOTG). At the time of this directive, 5 state maps relating to climatic data were filed in Section I.

(2) In early January 2001, each field office received from Walt Bolles, CRC, the current National Register of Historic Places for that particular county.

Filing Instructions. (1) Please have the person in charge of updating the FOTG in your office print new data from weather stations and file it in Section II, and if you have not done so already, please move state maps to Section II.

(2) According to 450-GM, Amendment 9, March 2000, this set of data is to be filed in Section II of the FOTG. Please have the person who updates the FOTG complete this. 450-GM also states that Section I should have a reference list for the National Register of Historic Places. Any updates are to be filed in Section II. Please have this website added to Section I, <http://www.cr.nps.gov/nr/nrhome.html>.
