

## Soils Legend

### Map Unit Symbols

Map unit symbols consists of letters, or a combination of numbers and letters (e.g., Br, MoD, AcD2). The two, or three letters represent the kind of soil or miscellaneous land areas. A capital letter of A, B, C, D, E, F or G following a lower case letter indicates the class of slopes. Soils without a slope letter are for those mapping units that are nearly level. A final number of 2 following a letter indicates that the soil is eroded. A number 3 indicates that the soil is severely eroded. Miscellaneous areas with a considerable range of slope may not have slope classes indicated.
