Subject. Release of updates for the South Carolina Technical Guide

Purpose. This notice transmits 3 additional Engineering Conservation Practice Standards, updates 12 Engineering Conservation Practice Standards, removes 9 Engineering Conservation Practice Standards, revises 1 Statement of Work, and adds 1 Practice Certification.

Effective Date. This notice is effective upon receipt.

Explanation. Conservation practice standards are periodically reviewed and revised in compliance with NRCS policy.

Conservation Practice Standard Additions and Revisions:

Amendments for the Treatment of Agricultural Waste (591) – The national standard was adopted for use South Carolina. This standard supersedes the previous standard Treatment of Poultry Litter to Reduce Soluble Phosphorous (193).

Animal Trails and Walkways (575) – The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Building Envelope Improvement (672) – The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Clearing and Snagging (326) – The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Dry Hydrant (432) – The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Irrigation Field Ditch (388) – The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Land Clearing (460) – The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Land Reclamation, Abandoned Mined Land (543) – The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Lighting System Improvement (670) – The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Recreation Land Grading and Shaping (566) – The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Row Arrangement (557) – The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Sediment Basin (350) – The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Sprinkler System (442) – The name has been changed from “Irrigation System, Sprinkler” to “Sprinkler System” and allows for uses other than irrigation. The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Stormwater Runoff Control (570) – The name has been changed from “Runoff Management System” to “Stormwater Runoff Control.” The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Waste Separation Facility (632) – The name has been changed from “Solid/Liquid Separation Facility” to “Waste Separation Facility.” The national standard was adopted for use in South Carolina.

Conservation Practice Standards Removed:

Irrigation Canal or Lateral (320) – This standard is no longer available for use in South Carolina.

Irrigation Land Leveling (464) – This standard is no longer available for use in South Carolina.

Land Reclamation, Toxic Discharge Control (455) – This standard is no longer available for use in South Carolina.

Land Reconstruction, Currently Mined Land (544) – This standard is no longer available for use in South Carolina.

Mine Shaft and Adit Closing (457) – This standard is no longer available for use in South Carolina.

Precision Land Smoothing (462) – This standard is no longer available for use in South Carolina.

Pumped Well Drain (532) – This standard is no longer available for use in South Carolina.

Rock Barrier (555) – This standard is no longer available for use in South Carolina.

Treatment of Poultry Litter to Reduce Soluble Phosphorous (193) – Superseded by Amendments for the Treatment of Agricultural Waste (591). This standard is no longer available for use in South Carolina.

Conservation Practice Statements of Work (SOW):

Sprinkler System (442) SOW – The statement of work is updated to reflect the new conservation practice name, clarifies the Design Deliverables, and highlights the steps of design certification, NRCS review, and installation certification.

Conservation Practice Certification:

Pumping Plant (533) – Provides documentation for the installation of pumping plant.
