**SOUTH CAROLINA TECHNICAL GUIDE
NOTICE 331**

Purpose: This notice transmits three (3) revised Conservation Practice Standards and removes seven (7) conservation practice standards from the Section IV of the South Carolina Field Office Technical Guide. These revisions have been posted on the electronic Field Office Technical Guide (eFOTG).

Effective Date: This notice is effective when received.

Explanation: Revised or Removed South Carolina Conservation Practice Standards.

Conservation Practice Standards:

Seasonal High Tunnel System for Crops (Code 798): This standard was updated so the definition no longer precludes electrical, heating and/or mechanical ventilation systems. Purposes were added to address air quality and energy as resource concerns

Irrigation Ditch Lining (Code 428): This standard has combined and updated the previous standards of Irrigation Water Conveyance, Galvanized Steel (Code 428A), Irrigation Water Conveyance, Non-reinforced Concrete (Code 428B), Irrigation Water Conveyance, Flexible Membrane (Code 428C)

Irrigation Water Conveyance, Galvanized Steel (Code 428A): This standard has been replaced by Irrigation Water Conveyance (Code 428).

Irrigation Water Conveyance, Non-reinforced Concrete (Code 428B): This standard has been replaced by Irrigation Water Conveyance (Code 428).

Irrigation Water Conveyance, Flexible Membrane (Code 428C): This standard has been replaced by Irrigation Water Conveyance (Code 428).



Land Reclamation, Landslide Treatment (Code 453): This practice standard will be removed from the SC FOTG.

Mole Drain (Code 482): This practice standard will be removed from the SC FOTG.

Pumped Well Drain (Code 532): This practice standard will be removed from the SC FOTG.

Spoil Spreading (Code 572): This practice standard has been updated so as to meet all requirements in the current national standard.

Waterspreading (Code 640): This practice standard will be removed from the SC FOTG.
