## **DESIGN**

---

### **Deliverables:**

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices:
  - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
  - b. List of required and/or facilitating practices.
  - c. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including, but not limited to:
    - i. Desired plant community.
    - ii. Erosion calculations.
    - iii. Vegetative manipulation
    - iv. Species selection.
    - v. Wildlife considerations.
  - d. Environmental considerations, including a resource inventory and environmental evaluation supported by a completed NRCS-CPA-52.
2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to install the practice and obtain necessary permits.
3. Operation and maintenance plan.
4. Certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and complies with applicable laws and regulations.

## **INSTALLATION**

---

### **Deliverables:**

1. Documentation of pre-application conference with client.
2. Documentation of staking and layout according to plans and specifications including applicable layout notes.
3. Design modification, if applicable, with facilitation and implementation approval from client and original designer.
4. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during application.
5. Certification that the application method and materials meets design requirements.

## **CHECK OUT**

### **Deliverables:**

1. Records of application.
  - a. Extent of practice units applied.
  - b. Actual materials used.
2. Certification that the application meets NRCS standards and specifications.
3. TechPRS progress report.
