Inspections and maintenance are required to achieve the intended function, benefits, and life of the practice. The landowner/operator is responsible to establish and implement an inspection and maintenance program. Items to inspect and maintain during the 1-year design life of the practice include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Ensure that all safety considerations and label directions supplied by the manufacture or vendor are followed.
2. Use caution such as personal protective gear when handling chemicals or biological amendments.
3. Ensure adequate ventilation is present where chemicals are stored.
4. Keep records of the amendments used, application rates, timing and any tests performed such as nutrient analysis's etc. Also keep records of any processes used to fine tune the amendment mixtures to achieve optimum results.
