This land clearing operation is planned to remove trees, stumps, and other vegetation to achieve your conservation objective. There is no minimum estimated life span for this practice. Land clearing operation requires the following operation and maintenance (O&M) activities be performed to ensure a successful project:

1. Inspect after significant storm events and promptly repair any eroded areas.
2. Maintain vegetative cover while controlling undesired and exotic vegetation until the intended conservation practice is operational and stable.
3. Ensure the protection of watercourses and water quality after land clearing operations. This may be accomplished by the use of approved best management practices.
4. Use caution when crossing cleared areas with heavy equipment when the ground is saturated.
5. Use approved methods for storing materials during clearing activities.
