Inspections and maintenance are required to achieve the intended function, benefits, and life of the practice. The landowner/operator is responsible to establish and implement an inspection and maintenance program. Items to inspect and maintain during the 1-year design life of the practice include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Inspect after significant storm events and at least bi-annually to identify repair and maintenance needs.
2. Fill or repair any excessive rills or gullies in the spoil to prevent any other resource concerns.
3. Reestablish vegetation as necessary on repaired areas.
4. Mow the vegetation as necessary to maintain a dense, vigorous stand.
5. Control undesirable species and/or noxious weeds as necessary.
