Inspections and maintenance are required to achieve the intended function, benefits, and life of the practice. The landowner/operator is responsible to establish and implement an inspection and maintenance program. Items to follow, inspect and/or maintain during the life of the practice include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Wear protective clothing when appropriate.
2. Records shall be kept for a period of at least five years, and include when appropriate:
 - a. The dates and quantities of waste imported to or from the agricultural production system.
 - b. Analysis of critical waste characteristics.
 - c. A description of how the waste was recycled and the conservation benefit achieved.
