Wildlife Watering Systems markets three watering facilities for wildlife use that meet the general requirements of Drawing TX-EN-0581 (prefabricated disk type) with the actual configurations as shown on the attached sketches. The four foot model will require a catchment apron to provide 35 gallons of water from an inch of rain.

These watering facilities will meet the Watering Facility standard dated September 2010. They are manufactured by KBK Industries, LLC, in Rush Center, KS. The wildlife watering systems being manufactured by KBK Industries LLC conform to the specifications set forth by ASTM Code D4097 - 01. General specifications on the tanks are listed below. The resin and glass makeup of each tank conforms to section 5 of the standard for contact molded glass fiber reinforced thermoset resin tanks. Per the agreement with Wildlife Watering Systems LLC and KBK Industries, a UV protective pigment is injected into the resin to enhance the protection from damaging UV rays. Visual inspections and barcol hardness tests are completed to insure the quality and conformity of each tank. KBK Industries has manufactured and sold fiberglass tanks for over 35 years and are on several NRCS approved Manufacturers lists throughout the Mid-West.

The wildlife watering systems being manufactured by KBK Industries LLC conform to the specifications set forth by ASTM Code D4097 – 01. General specifications on the tanks are listed below. The resin and glass makeup of each tank conforms to section 5 of the standard for contact molded glass fiber reinforced thermoset resin tanks. Per the agreement with Wildlife Watering Systems LLC and KBK Industries, a UV protective pigment is injected into the resin to enhance the protection from damaging UV rays. Visual inspections and barcol hardness tests are completed to insure the quality and conformity of each tank. KBK Industries has manufactured and sold fiberglass tanks for over 35 years and are on several NRCS approved Manufacturers lists through out the Mid-West.
