



National Supplement to Animal Enhancement Activity – ANM57 – Removal of all threats to sensitive wildlife species on the operation

Sage Grouse Initiative (SGI)

The purpose of this activity is to implement a management plan:

- Which addresses all identified threats to sage grouse on the operation within the land manager’s control, and
- Demonstrates the identified threats are being mitigated/managed according to the plan.

This activity is particularly suited to operations which have already made significant progress in addressing threats to sage grouse and which desire to manage to an even higher level while maintaining previously achieved benefits to sage grouse.

Since addressing some threats completely may not be possible within the CSP contract lifespan (e.g., removal of all invasive weeds) or the threat requires prolonged management, the management plans must show where the threats occur on the operation, the treatment schedule, and progress milestones to the extent practical during the contract.

Threats beyond the control of the operator (e.g., public utilities and roads through the operation or threats on adjacent lands) are not required to be addressed.

Furthermore, this enhancement will be implemented in accordance with all Conservation Measures in the Biological Opinion is available online at “SGI website link.”

Clarification of Adoption Requirements

This enhancement will be considered adopted when the subject management plan documented as being implemented per the schedule, thus demonstrating all identified threats to sage grouse which are within control of the operator on the land use have been diminished/realized as the plan’s progress milestones.
