DEFINITION

Row Arrangement is establishing a system of crop rows on planned grades and lengths primarily for erosion control and/or water management.

PRACTICE INFORMATION

The purpose of the practice is to establish rows in the appropriate direction, grade, and length to provide:

- Adequate drainage
- Reduced erosion
- More efficient use of moisture
