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Operation and Maintenance:

Sediment accumulations along strip edges shall be smoothed or removed and distributed over the field as necessary to maintain effectiveness.

Mow sod turn-strips at least once per year. Harvesting is optional.

Erosion-resistant strips in rotation shall be managed to maintain the planned vegetative cover and surface roughness.

If strip alignment is lost due to adjacent strips being in hay or permanent cover, the original strip alignment and width will be reestablished as needed.
