ACCESS CONTROL

The temporary or permanent exclusion of animals, people, vehicles, and/or equipment from an area.

PURPOSE

Achieve and maintain desired resource conditions by monitoring and managing the intensity of use by animals, people, vehicles, and/or equipment in coordination with the application schedule of practices, measures and activities specified in the conservation plan.

CRITERIA

Each activity or measure will identify the entity to be monitored and regulated (animals, people, vehicles and/or equipment) and specify the intent, intensity, amounts, and timing of exclusion of the targeted entity.

Barriers associated with roads and trails shall be adequately marked to safeguard human safety and minimize the risk of liability.

Barriers should account for and minimize impact on public safety activities such as fire control.

Barrier type and design should account for and minimize impact to impair wildlife health and animal movement.

PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS

Plans and specifications for applying this practice shall be prepared for each site and recorded:

- » Approved Conservation Plan
- » Benchmark condition
- » Map showing location and as-built criteria of what was installed
- » Resource concern protected by temporary or permanent exclusion
- » Barriers used
- » Actual practices according to design



Gates and fences can selectively control use of an area by animals, people and vehicles.



Poorly timed use of vehicles can accelerate sheet, rill, and concentrated flow erosion on access roads and trails.

OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

Monitoring of the effectiveness of use-regulating activities will be performed routinely and at least annually with changes made to specifications and operation and maintenance requirements as necessary to achieve the desired resource conditions.

Modifications to activities and use of measures are allowed temporarily to accommodate emergency-level contingencies such as wildfire, drought, or flood as long as desired resource conditions are maintained.

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COST SHARE DOCUMENTATION FOR CASE FILE

Before payment is made, the following information is required to be in the case file:

- Plan or location map, or photograph of the field and documentation of practice layout according to plans and specifications is present in the client case file and include the following:
 - » the approximate location of the keyline(s) used to establish the system with design minimum and maximum grade,
 - » the location of stable outlets and outlets needing treatment identified, and
 - » the location of all existing or planned supporting conservation practices needed to control surface water runoff.

- Field verification is documented and a certified planner verified “as installed” this practice meets NRCS standards and specifications.
 - » engineering design to include as-built documentation where appropriate.
