

STATEMENT OF WORK

CROSS WIND RIDGES (588)

DESIGN

Deliverables:

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices:
 - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
 - b. List all required and/or facilitating practices.
 - c. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
 - i. Ridge height and spacing
 - ii. Orientation of ridges in relation to direction of erosive winds
 - iii. Period ridges must be present and maintained
 - iv. Erosion calculations
2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client that adequately describe the requirements to apply the practice. Plans and specifications shall be developed in accordance with the requirements of conservation practice standard 588 Cross Wind Ridges and documented on the Wisconsin NRCS Job Sheet 588 Cross Wind Ridges.
3. Operation and maintenance plan.
4. Certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and the practice comply with applicable laws and regulations.
5. Design modifications during application as required are documented.

INSTALLATION

Deliverables:

1. Application guidance as needed.
2. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer.
3. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during application.
4. Certification that the application meets design requirements.

CHECK OUT

Deliverables:

1. Records of application:
 - a. Applied ridge height, ridge spacing, direction and orientation
 - b. Extent of practice units applied
2. Certification that the application meets NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits documented on the Wisconsin NRCS Job Sheet 588 Cross Wind Ridges or in the client's case file.
3. Progress reporting.
