

1. Open now (Dec 1st) through Feb 26, 2016.
2. Competitive enrollment opportunity for both Landowners & Operators that meet the eligibility requirements as determined by FSA.
3. Accepted contracts begin Oct 1st, 2016.
4. All submitted offers are scored & ranked using the EBI Environmental Benefit Index.
5. EBI rankings are unique to each tract of land offered.
6. Each offer competes with all other offers.
7. Producers can increase their EBI scores by offering to enroll the most environmentally sensitive sites and by planting diverse stands of native species.
