Explanation of Changes/Revisions:

Section IV

- Standard 397-now includes a minimum freeboard height for perimeter embankments
- Standard 560
 - the table containing minimum distances between drainage structures was revised based on the current WDNR Division of Forestry publication that is the reference for the table
 - a surfacing option was added using geogrid
- Standard 561- a surfacing option was added using geogrid
- Standard 575- the table containing minimum distances between drainage structures was revised based on the current WDNR Division of Forestry publication that is the reference for the table
- Standard 580
 - several references were updated or deleted
 - the definition of bioengineering was revised to include non-living, biodegradable materials.
