The following revisions to the Wisconsin FOTG have been posted on the Wisconsin e-FOTG website:

Section IV

- Index
- Standard 396, Fish Passage
- Standard 412, Grassed Waterway
- Standard 447, Irrigation System, Tailwater Recovery
- Standard 574, Spring Development

Section IV

- Standard 396, Fish Passage, has been completely rewritten nationally. Wisconsin has adopted the changes with minor additions.
- Standard 412, Grassed Waterway, has had a minor revision to allow the use of retardance C or D for determining the maximum velocity in waterways that are diked.
- Standard 447, Irrigation System, Tailwater Recovery, has had minor revisions. The term “irrigation pit” was changed to “collecting basin.” The definition now includes the collection of rainfall runoff in addition to irrigation water for reuse.
- Standard 574, Spring Development, has been revised to be consistent with the national standard.
