Explanation of Changes/Revisions:

Section II:

- The Classification of Conservation Practice Effects on Cultural Resources has been updated to include the new standard.

Section IV:

- Standard 311, Alley Cropping, is a new standard.
- Standards 328, 340, 484, 345, 329, 346, 344, and 384 have had minor revisions to include energy criteria in order to coincide with the national standards. In addition to incorporating energy criteria, Standard 340, Cover Crop, has been updated to include language regarding the approval process for non-listed cover crop mixtures; and Standard 384, Woody Residue Treatment, has had a title change (formerly Forest Slash Treatment).
- A Statement of Work has been added for new Standard 311.

Section V:

- A CPPE worksheet for Standard 311 has been added.
